

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) - Domestique by LTDL

Registration

1. What is Domestique by LTDL?

- a. Domestique by LTDL is an amateur cycling event open for cycling enthusiasts to experience the LTDL actual race route and concept.
- b. Participants can either compete in their respective race categories or just enjoying themselves having the experience of LTDL.

2. What is the distance for Domestique by LTDL?

- a. 96.5 KM

3. When is Domestique by LTDL flag off date and time?

- a. 28 September 2024, 7.00am

4. When should I arrive in Langkawi?

- a. You are advised to arrive in Langkawi at least 1 day before the event ie 27 September 2024 to collect your race kit.
- b. All participants are required to wear their race bib and bike number to be allowed to enter the starting area.

5. What kind of bike are allowed to participate?

- a. All road bicycle are allowed
- b. However, the following bikes are STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED
 - i. Bikes with Disc Wheels / Rim Covers;
 - ii. Bikes with Aero or Extension Bars;
 - iii. Bikes with Fixed Wheels with No Brakes; Fixie Bikes;
 - iv. Specialist Time Trial Bikes
 - v. Motorised Bikes;
 - vi. Unicycles;
 - vii. Scooters.

6. Who is eligible to participate in Domestique by LTDL?

- a. Domestique by LTDL is open to all cyclists aged 16 years old and above as at 31 December 2024, both men and women, Malaysian and non-Malaysian
- b. All 16 year old cyclists must provide a letter of consent from his/her parent/guardian to participate.

7. I'll be coming from overseas, do i need to arrange for a visa to participate in Domestique by LTDL?

- a. All participants must adhere to the latest VISA requirement by the Malaysia Government. <https://www.malaysia.gov.my/portal/content/28905>

- b. The organiser does not provide any special arrangement for VISA application to Malaysia

8. What are the benefits from the registration fees?

- a. Race Kit - Bib with timing chip and tote bag
- b. Insurance coverage during the race
- c. Finisher Medal
- d. Finisher T-Shirt
- e. Selected Food & Beverages at Feeding Areas

9. Is a cycling licence required for participation?

- a. Cyclists are encouraged to have a cycling licence issued by any cycling federation. However, it is not a mandatory requirement for participation.

10. What are the categories for competition?

- a. Men Junior 16 to 22 years old
- b. Men A 23 to 35 years old
- c. Men B 36 to 40 years old
- d. Men C 41 to 45 years old
- e. Men D 46 to 50 years old
- f. Men E 51 years old and above
- g. Women Open 16 to 35 years old
- h. Women Master 36 years old and above
- i. Best Team Minimum of 5 cyclists from any of the above
- j. Best Sprint
- k. King Of Mountain (KOM)

11. How many winners are there for each category?

- a. All Individual categories will have 10 winners
- b. Best Team category will have 3 winners.

12. How is the winner for each category besides SPRINT and KOM being determined?

- a. All the cyclist's time will be recorded and to be ranked accordingly based on completion at the finishing line.

13. How is the winner for SPRINT and KOM being determined?

- a. Winner will be determined by the fastest time captured between starting point and finishing point of the sprint or climb area.

14. What is the requirement to participate in the competition categories?

- a. Current (2024) Continental and/or National Team Cyclists are allowed to participate in the event but are not eligible to win any of the categories.

15. How to register for a team?

- a. Cyclist will need to fill up his/her team name during registration if they want to be recognized under their team. Kindly make sure all spelling is correct to avoid any miscommunication between the cyclist, the team and the event organiser.
- b. The minimum number of cyclists required for a team to be recognized during the event is 5 cyclists.
- c. There are no additional requirements to be a team. It can be a mixture of gender or age or from the same gender or age.

16. Can I apply for a refund for cancelling my registration?

- a. All Domestique tickets are final and non-refundable. Any cancellation/transfer/refund requests will not be entertained.

17. Can I transfer my registration to another person?

- a. Cyclists are not allowed to transfer their registration to another person for safety and security reasons.

18. Is there a time limit for finishing the race?

- a. The time limit to finish the race is within 5 hours after flag off.
